Defining IP Camera Settings

Step 1

Connect one end of the network cable (LAN) to the camera Ethernet port and the other side to your router. Power up the camera with an appropriate power supply.

Step 2

If the camera is connected to a VUpoint NVR, refer to the VUpoint Network Video Recorder Installation Guide for further installation instructions. If the camera is installed as a stand-alone camera (without NVR connection), follow steps 3 – 6 below.

Step 3

Log into your Installer Admin Application and select a Site. Click Network Cameras → click [+ Add New Camera](#) and then enter the definitions into the provided fields.

Définition des paramètres de la caméra IP

Étape 1
